Plan Your Visit

Trailhead: 727 Mosher Hill Rd, Farmington

Parking: Available across the street from the trailhead.

Trail Length: ~ 0.1 miles to the falls, an additional 0.2 miles if you take the loop.

Trail Description: Informal streamside loop trail.

Difficulty: Moderate

Guidelines:

- Practice Leave No Trace
- Non-motorized use only
- Respect our neighbors
- No fires
- No overnight camping
